

More motions to be filed on the murder of the Avetisyans

On July 12, 2016, the Court dismissed the motion on self-recusal of the judge.

On 21st court hearing of the murder of the Avetisyan family



On July 29, 2016, the General Jurisdiction Court of Shirak Marz (Region) held its next-in-turn outgoing hearing of the murder of the Avetisyan family.

At the court hearing, defendant Valery Permyakov's attorney Eduard Aghajanyan filed a motion on declaring the evidence obtained through the 1st questioning of his client inadmissible on the grounds that during the questioning above, it was not permitted by law to invite an attorney from the Armenian side.

The victims' successors and their representatives also joined the motion.

First, judge Harutyun Movsesyan ruled to consider the motion later, but the lawyers insisted that the consideration of the motion was essential at that stage of trial examination; then the Court ruled to adjourn the court hearing.

The motion will be considered at the next court hearing.

At the next court hearing, Chairman of HCA Vanadzor A. Sakunts, representative of the victim's successors, will file 2 more motions.

The next court hearing is scheduled for August 5, 2016, at 12 pm.
