Executive Summary

HCA Vanadzor collected the data on the death cases in January-September 2016 from the information disseminated by the mass media and official sources as well as provided by the families of the deceased servicemen.

According to the findings of the study by HCA Vanadzor, in January-September 2016, **146 private soldiers and contract servicemen**, including the **volunteers** in the four-day hostilities, deceased in the RA armed forces and NK defense army. Also, during the hostilities of April 2, 2016, **4 civilians were identified as perished in Talish**.

Besides, Artak Petrosyan, contract serviceman at Russian Border-guard military unit N, also died in a car accident in August, 2016.

Out of the 146 death cases in January-September 2016, 77 cases were caused by the hostilities of April 1-5, and **28 of the other 69 cases** were caused by ceasefire violations, **15 cases** were caused by accidents (5 cases - by car accidents, 3 cases – by natural disasters /1 case – by avalanches and 2 cases – by floods/, 2 cases – by dugout collapse, 2 cases – by breach of driving and vehicle operation rules, 1 case - by electric shock, 1 case – by drowning and 1 case – by explosion); **12 cases** were caused by murder (5 cases - by the breach of the rules for handling weapons, 3 cases – by violations of statutory relations, 3 cases – by circumstances not established yet and 1 case - by deliberate murder); **10 cases** were caused by suicide or causing somebody to commit suicide; **3 cases** were caused by the breach of the rules for military service and **1 case** was caused by health problems, namely infarction.

In 2 (1 car accident and 1 suicide) death cases, the military servicemen were not on their service at the material time.

The conscript soldier who died in a car accident was on vacation at the material time. While no official statement was issued on the incident, in his interview to Razminfo military news website,¹ Artsrun Hovhannisyan, Press Spokesperson of the RA Defense Minister, disclosed that.

Captain Mesrop Ghurshudyan, 2nd Platoon Commander of Military Unit N of the RA Defense Ministry, committed a suicide by hanging himself in his bathroom. The RA Defense Ministry issued no official statement on the incident, and as for the RA Investigation Committee, its statement has no mention of the cause of the suicide of the serviceman.² Thus, there is no information on the link between the fact of the suicide and issues related to the military service.³

To compare, it should be noted that in the same period of 2015, **56 deaths cases were identified**. **31** of the 56 cases were caused by ceasefire violations; **12** cases – by accidents (11 car accidents, 1 accident in still unclear circumstances), **5** cases – by suicide or causing somebody to commit suicide, **4** cases – by murder (1 case – by deliberate murder and 3 cases – by breach of rules of martial service), **3** cases – by health problems and **1** case – by breach of rules of martial service.

The data above suggest that in the same period of 2016 the death cases caused by ceasefire violations, except for the number of casualties caused by the April hostilities and the ceasefire violations following them, decreased by 3 times as compared to 2015. However, the number of death cases caused by murders rose drastically, 4 times (3 in 2015 and 12 in 2016) and that of suicides rose twice (5 in 2015 and 10 in 2016).

2 of the 105 death cases (including the 77 death cases of the hostilities of April 1-5 and 28 death cases caused by ceasefire violations) caused by the ceasefire violations in January-September 2016 occurred on the territory of the RA, one of the cases occurred in Chambarak community of Tavush marz (region) and the other in Vayots Dzor marz.

Statistical data and outline of ceasefire violations, death cases and weapons used in January-September 2016

Chart 1 presents the change in the death cases caused by ceasefire violations in the first 9 months of 2016.

Number of death cases due to ceasefire violations in January-September 2016⁴

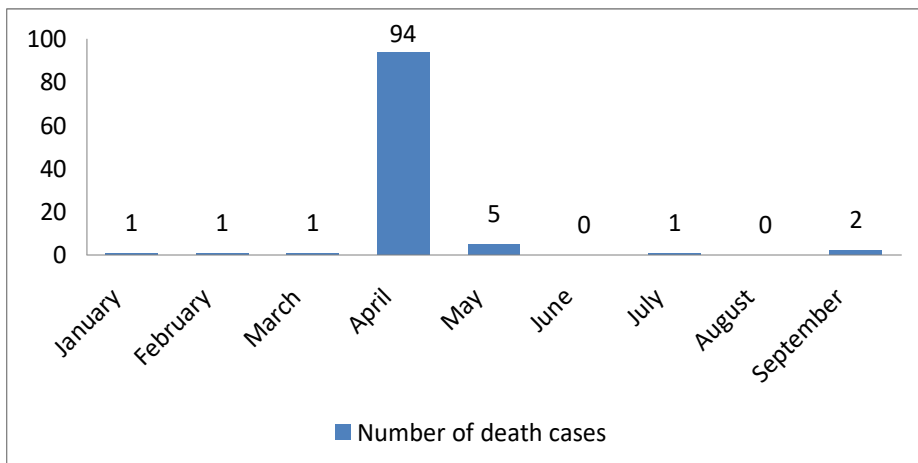


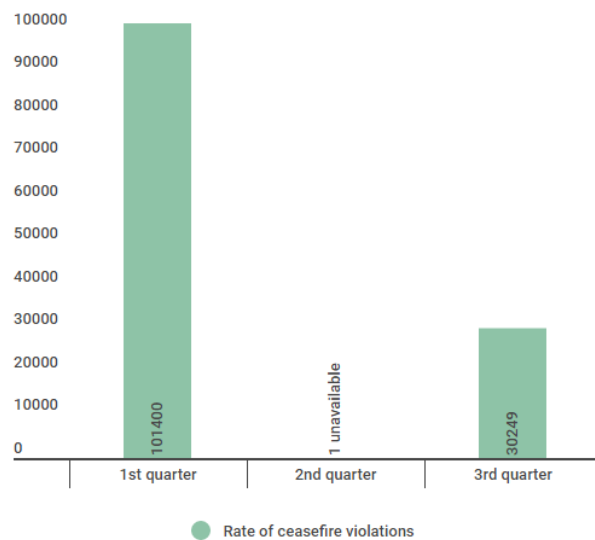

The data above show that the number of shots due to ceasefire violations in the 1st quarter of 2016 before the April hostilities exceeded by 3 times that in the 3rd quarter.

Chart 3 shows the number of shots due to ceasefire violations and the military servicemen perished from such shots in the first 9 months of 2016.

It is noteworthy that the number of shots due to ceasefire violation in April-June 2016 is not provided as no official information is available. While the unavailability of statistics on April might be accounted for by the April hostilities, the unavailability of statistics for May-June cannot be accounted for by any reason.

Starting from 2015, the statements issued by the press service of the NK Defense Ministry also contain information on the weapons used by the enemy's armed forces and the number of such arms. The study of the official website of the NK Defense Ministry press service resulted in the picture below of the weapons used by the enemy and the shots made from them (see Table 2).

It is noteworthy that while the official communications issued by NK Ministry of Defense before April of 2016 mostly mentioned the types of the weapons used, very often they lacked the quantity of the shells used.

As we can see from the above, starting from 2015 till April of 2016, the armed forces of the enemy most often used mortars with a diameter of 60 and 82 mm and various types of grenade launchers. Also, rifle weapons of various calibers were used; however, the official website of the NK Defense Ministry mostly provides no information on their types in its communications.

Starting from June 2016, the Press Service of the NK Defense Ministry published official data on the frequency of ceasefire violations and fired shot during the day. It is noteworthy that according to data disclosed by the Press Service of the NK Defense Ministry, in July-September, the enemy violated the ceasefire 2347 times by firing 30249 shots from rifle-type weapons. In the period above, the enemy mostly fired no shots from any other weapons. According to data published by the Press Service of the NK Defense Ministry, the enemy used DShK heavy machine gun 5 times by firing over 77 shots.

Note that during the hostilities that started on the night on April 2, 2016 and lasted 4 days, the Azerbaijani armed forces used weapons that had not been used since the cease-fire agreement of 1994.

Unlike the previous years, starting from January 2016, the enemy began to use missile station TR-107, and starting from April of the same year, the enemy began to use MM21, Zenith system ZU-23-2, Zenith-rocket complex 9M33 M3, infantry fighting vehicle (IFV), anti-tank guided missile SPIKE and 85, 100, 122 and 152 mm cannons.

Unlike all the other years and the 1st quarter of 2016, the 2nd quarter of 2016 saw an incomparably increased number of shots from mortars and grenade launchers. In particular, unlike the 1st half of 2015 when 110 shells of grenade launchers and 252 mortar shells were fired at the Armenian

positions, in the same period of 2016 the number of shells of grenade launchers totaled 497 and that of mortars totaled 1091.

In April-June 2016, jet missile stations were also used: 1183 shells.

According to analysts, during the 4-day hostilities, the Armenian side suffered material losses of 14 million USD, and Azerbaijan – those of 170 million USD.⁶

The United Nations Register of Conventional Arms⁷ in use since 1992 covers 7 categories of arms on which various countries should provide annual import and export data. The categories include as follows:

1. battle tanks;
2. armored combat vehicles;
3. large-caliber artillery systems;
4. combat aircraft;
5. attack helicopters;
6. warships;
7. missiles

The weapons (artillery, artillery missile system) used by the enemy in January-March 2016 are included in the list of the UN Conventional Arms.

The Treaty on Conventional Arms is violated through acquisition of various types of weapons in a quantity exceeding that limited by the Treaty, which heightens the tension in the region and undermines the negotiation process for the peaceful resolution of Nagorno-Karabakh conflict.

Breakdown of criminal cases initiated on death cases in January-September 2016 under articles of RA Criminal Code

According to the information collected by HCA Vanadzor, 42 criminal cases were initiated on 146 death cases in January-September 2016. HCA Vanadzor used the official website of the RA

Investigative Committee as the source of this information; also, the Organization staff collected information from relevant visits and the people who consulted them. As for the rest 104 cases, no official information on initiating criminal proceedings has been disclosed yet.

- 8 criminal cases were initiated under Article 104(2)(2 and 13), RA Criminal Code, i.e. murder out of motives of national, racial or religious hatred or fanaticism;
- 3 criminal cases were initiated under Article 104(2)(6 and 13), RA Criminal Code, i.e. murder in a manner dangerous for the lives of many people out of motives of national, racial or religious hatred or fanaticism;
- 3 criminal cases were initiated under Article 104(1), RA Criminal Code, i.e. murder: illegal willful deprivation of one's life;
- 1 criminal case was initiated under Article 376(2), RA Criminal Code, i.e. negligent attitude to service if it caused grave consequences;
- 5 criminal cases were initiated under Article 373(3), RA Criminal Code, i.e. breach of rules for handling weapons, ammunition and radioactive materials, explosives and other items and devices dangerous for the environment, which negligently caused the human death;
- 3 criminal cases were initiated under Article 242(3), RA Criminal Code, i.e. breach of rules of traffic or operating transportation vehicles by persons driving them, which negligently caused the death of 2 or more persons;
- 9 criminal cases were initiated under Article 110(1), RA Criminal Code, i.e. causing somebody to commit suicide or make an attempt at a suicide by indirect willfulness or by negligence, by means of threat, cruel treatment or regular humiliation of one's dignity;
- 2 criminal cases were initiated under Article 377(2), RA Criminal Code, i.e. breach of rules for driving or operating vehicles which negligently caused human death;
- 1 criminal case was initiated under Article 365(3), RA Criminal Code, i.e. violation of combat duty or combat service rules;
- the statement on 1 case issued by the RA Investigative Committee has no mention of the article of the RA Criminal Code under which the criminal proceedings were initiated but only mentions the article under which charges were brought against the person;⁸

- on 6 death cases, criminal proceedings were initiated, but there are no details on the articles of the RA Criminal Code under which they were initiated.⁹

According to the news report disseminated by panarmenian.net news website on June 30, 2016,¹⁰ the NK Prosecutor General's Office initiated 6 criminal cases on the murder of NKR Defense Army servicemen and torture of their bodies during the hostilities of April 2016.

In particular, 3 separate criminal proceedings were initiated on beheading of Kyaram Sloyan (the proceedings were initiated on April 2), Hrant Gharibyan (the proceedings were initiated on April 2) and Hayk Toroyan (the proceedings were initiated on April 3).

Also, criminal proceedings were initiated on the murders of Rafik Hakobyan and Aghasi Asatryan (the proceedings were initiated on April 3) and the murders of Andranik Zohrabyan and Robert Abajyan (the proceedings were initiated on April 8).

Another criminal case was initiated on the torturing of the bodies of 15 servicemen below: Lieutenant Colonel Roman Arakelyan, Lieutenant Colonel Aleksan Arakelyan, Lieutenant Colonel Onik Grigoryan, Major Suren Melkumyan, Senior Lieutenant Maksim Grigoryan, private soldiers Zhora Yesayan, Bagrat Aleksanyan, Boris Ozmanyanyan, Grigor Harutyunyan, Sergeant Adam Sahakyan, contract private soldier Andranik Grigoryan, private soldier Tigran Berakchyan, private soldier Arman Andrasyan, private soldier Azat Simonyan and Lieutenant Ashot Shahbazyan; 9 of them were private soldiers and 5 were officers who were surrounded and considered missing for a few days. These proceedings also covered a death case of a private soldier. The proceedings were initiated on April 10, 2016.

Information on initiation of criminal proceedings and their progress was disclosed not on all the death cases of April-June 2016. Therefore, since it is impossible to find on the media and official websites integral information on the criminal proceedings on death cases after April, HCA Vanadzor requested in an official letter the RA Defense Ministry to provide information, but by its response letter, the Ministry refused to provide such information invoking Article 3(1)(14) of the RA Law on Protection of Personal Data, and the RA Investigative Committee provided no response at all to the

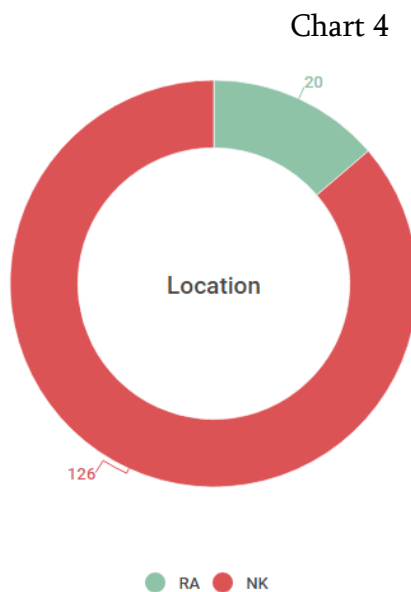
question above. It is also noteworthy that the families of the servicemen mostly had no information on initiation of criminal proceedings.

Statistics and Outline of the Death Cases in January-September 2016

Out of 146 servicemen who died in January-September 2016, 23 were contract servicemen, 21 were volunteers, 20 were officers and 83 were conscript soldiers.

On 142 death cases there are official reports; the information was disseminated by the primary sources below: the official website of the NK Defense Ministry¹¹, the official website of the RA Investigative Committee,¹² Artsrun Hovhannisyan, Press Spokesperson of the RA Defense Ministry.

20 of the death cases occurred in the Republic of Armenia and 126 in Nagorno-Karabakh (see Chart 4).



Below are the statistics of the death cases in January-September 2016, by their causes (see Table 3 and Chart 5), brief outline of the death cases (see Table 4) and the data available on the circumstances of death.

Causes of death cases in January-September 2016

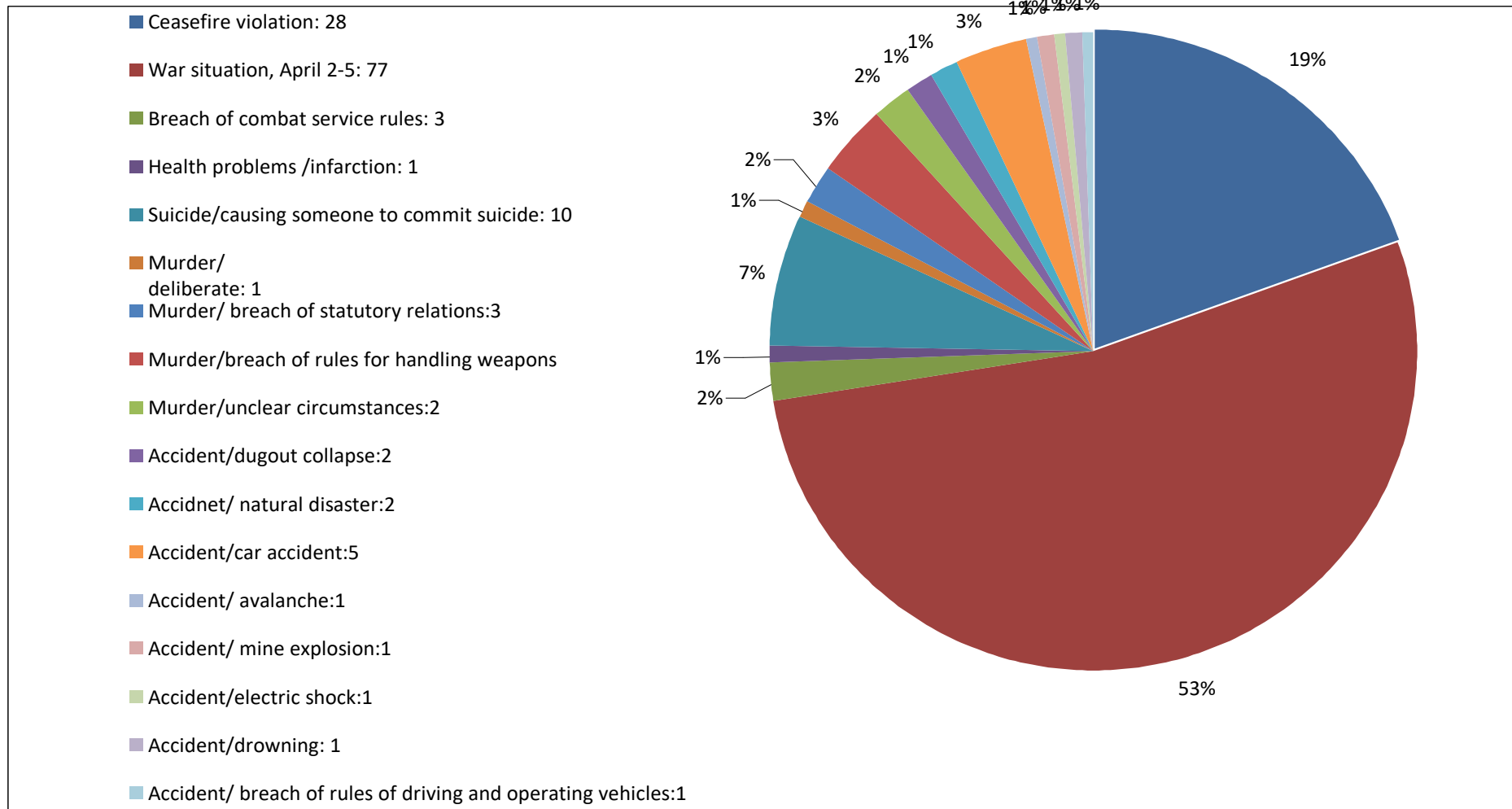
